Call for applications for tzNOG3 training in Zanzibar, 30th Aug - 4th Sept 2015

tzNOG is a multi-stakeholder project that aims at providing affordable capacity building platform to IT Professionals in Tanzania for better management of Internet Infrastructure and Resources. Its organizing committee comprises of members from Tanzania Network Information Centre (tzNIC), Tanzania Communications Regulatory Authority (TCRA), Tanzania Internet Service Providers Association (TISPA) and Tanzania Educational and Research Network (TERNET).

In collaboration with the Ministry of Communication, Science and Technology and other Sponsors, the tzNOG organizing committee has organized the 3rd tzNOG training event in Zanzibar from **30th August to 4th September 2015** at **Ocean View Hotel (City Centre)**. This annual training comes in Zanzibar after two successful trainings in Arusha (in 2013) and Mwanza (in 2014).

This year's training will be lead by Instructors from NSRC (www.nsrc.org), AfNOG (www.afnog.org) and tzNOG (www.tznog.or.tz) and will have 3 main tracks that will be preceded by a half day bootcamp on UNIX administration. The main tracks are:

- a) Systems and Network Security (SNS)
- b) Network Management and Monitoring (NMM) and
- c) Routing and Switching (R&S).

Note that all the tracks will also cover IPv6 basics and configuration concepts.

Application requirements:

The training session is open to all technical staff managing internet resources/infrastructure within their Institutions such as mail servers, web servers, etc. The main requirements are:

- Some Linux/UNIX experience
- Knowledge of TCP/IP protocols and layer 2 & 3 network basics.

Training fee:

Successful candidates will have to pay training fee of **TZS 300,000.00** (TZS Three Hundred Thousand only). This fee is meant to cover the conference package (morning and afternoon tea/coffee and lunch), internet connectivity, stationeries and administration costs.

Note that:

- a) Accommodation is not included and therefore participants should make their own accommodation arrangements.
- b) Fee payment of TZS 300,000.00 **has been extended to 15th August 2015**. From 16th August 2015 onwards participants will have to pay TZS 350,000.00.
