The University of Dar es Salaam, invites applications for admission into the Master of Science in Geographical Information Systems (MSc. GIS) Programme.

Programme Objective

This program is formulated to produce competent GIS Analysts, GIS Developers, GIS Programmers, GIS Managers and GIS Users. It provides advanced training of GIS technology to be used for solving social, economic, political and environmental issues at national local, and international levels. The programme enrolls applicants who have a Barcherlor Degree, or a Postgraduate diploma in a subject or discipline that employ spatial sciences or have informal and non-formal learning in GIS from any recognised institution and qualify for Masters Programme at UDSM.

Commencement

The program is scheduled to commence on November 9th, 2015.

Duration

The MSc. GIS programme runs for 18 months. Minimum

Entry Requirements

- i. Applicants must be holders of a Bachelor's degree with a GPA of at least 2.7 or its equivalent from any accredited University in any field of study. OR
- ii. Non-degree applicants with an Advanced Diploma (second class or higher) and Postgraduate Diploma.

Mode of Delivery

MSc. GIS is an evening programe offered by the Deaprtment of Geography at UDSM. The programme is structured into 180 credits.

120 credits are for coursework and 60 credits are for dissertation. In each semester students will be required to take 5 core courses and a minimum of 1 optional course. This structure guarantees 45 contact hours per taught subject for each of the 12 courses.

The minimum prescribed contact hours per day are 3,

of which a minimum of 1 hour is set aside for seminars, assignment, or practical. The MSc. GIS is completed in 18 months, divided into 12 months of course examinations and 6 months work and for dissertation. Note: The theoretical part of the programme is supported by carefully designed problem independent projects, solving assignments and practicals in up to date GIS laboratories at the University.
